K of C Richmond District 23 Annual Golf Tournament Details

TEXAS SCRAMBLE FORMAT:

1. Each foursome will consist of two teams of two players.
2. All four players tee off at each hole.
3. The team leader then selects the best drive and marks the position (within 6 inches) with a tee peg.
4. The other player retrieves the ball.
5. The player whose ball has been chosen then plays his next shot first.
6. The other player then plays within 6 inches of the tee peg.
7. The above method of play is followed until the green is reached.
8. On the green the same method is applied. The ball chosen is marked by a putter head length and the player putts from the same spot in turn.
9. Each player must mark the ball after putting. Play continues from each chosen position until the ball is holed.
10. The score is the total number of shots from the chosen spot including the tee shot.

SCORING:

1. The Golf Committee will provide one official scorecard for each foursome.
2. The foursomes choose only one scorer for both teams.
3. The Scorer records each team's score for each hole (do not record strokes taken by each individual player). In other words, your scorecard should show two sets of scores, one for each team.
4. For each hole, count all strokes until the ball is in the hole. There will be no "give me". When you reach a count equal to double par, stop play and move on to the next hole, to avoid congestion.
5. The official scorecard should be handed immediately to the golf tournament committee after the 18th hole, properly filled up and signed by the team leaders and without too many erasures.
6. Unofficial scorecard and not properly filled up as per instructions will not be accepted and the foursome will be disqualified.

AWARDS/TROPHIES:

***Low Gross Team Winner** - Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the Low Gross Team Winner. (Their names will be printed on metal plate and will be attached to the perpetual trophy). The K of C Council who sponsored the winners will keep the perpetual trophy. An individual small trophy will be given to the Low Gross Team Winners.

***Second Low Gross Team Winners** – will be awarded only an individual small trophy.

***Longest Drive** – Individual trophy only. (Hole 18 for men. Hole 9 for ladies).

***Closest to the Pin (men and ladies)** – No Trophy only prizes. Holes will be announced before the tournament.

***Hole in One** – **\$100.00 cash will be awarded.** Hole no. will be announced at the tournament.

NOTES:

A) To be eligible for Long Drive and Closest to the Pin, a shot must come to rest on the Fairway or on the Green. If your ball ends up in the rough, sand trap or out of bounds, it does not qualify.

B) Trophies will be awarded after the tournament at the Big Tent. Trophies should be return to the committee for engraving the names of winners.

C) After awarding, please return trophies to the committee for labeling of winner names and will be return to the winners at later date.

TIE- BREAKER:

In the event of a tie, a count back will be made from the score on the back nine. The lower score will count as a winner.

LUNCH/PRIZES:

Immediately after the tournament, lunch will be served at the Big Tent and there will be raffle of prizes.
